A public hearing on the "2024/2025 Budget" and "Truth-in-Taxation" will be the first agenda item at the Regular meeting. You are all invited to attend this meeting, as you are every township board meeting, to review the 2024/2025 Budget and give your input. A Special Township Board Meeting has also been scheduled for Friday March 29th at 6:00 pm to amend and close-out our fiscal year 2023/2024 Budget and to officially adopt our 2024/2025 Budget, you are all invited to attend this meeting as well.

Finally, this is Board of Review month. If anyone has questions on their tax assessments or other issues regarding your property taxes the Marenisco Township Board of Review (BOR) will meet, accept petitions and act on said petitions on March  $11^{th}$  from 3 pm - 9 pm and March  $12^{th}$  from 9 am - 3 p. in the township hall at 314 Hall Street.

Pray for moisture (snow/rain) and go help out your neighbors – our local business owners. I'll see you next month.


